

Texas Red Buckeye

Aesculus pavia



A unique & beautiful **native** understory tree found in the woods of East Texas. Produces showy, 10"-12" panicles of red flowers in early spring. The foliage emerges a beautiful copper color & unfurls into palmate, widespread leaves. Grows best in shade or partial shade protected from strong afternoon sun. May go dormant if they get too dry in late summer. Avg 12' x 8', but can reach 20'x10'. Moist, well-drained soil.
