

## **Mexican Beautyberry** *Callicarpa mexicana*

**Could be called our native beautyberry on steroids! This lush plant produces much larger clusters of gorgeous burgundy wine berries along the stems in the fall and all winter. The berries remain into the winter, and are eaten by several species of birds.**

**Averages 6'-8' tall.**

**Deciduous. Full sun to dappled shade. Drought tolerant once established. Birds!**
