Stipa tenuissima

A gorgeous native Texas grass!!! Low growing, about 18" tall, with very fine bright green foliage that forms attractive dense clumps. In late spring, Mexican Feather Grass produces silky looking flowers that look like a flowing mane of blond hair when mature. Gorgeous whether in decorative containers, as single specimens, or in spectacular mass plantings. It's also good for erosion control & for coastal gardens. Fertile, well drained soil. Sun or part shade.
